We are glad to have Pr. Samuel Fatoki Sr. present God's word this week. He has been referred to us by Brianna Waters who recently joined our praise group as a vocalist. Pr. Samuel answered God's call to establish the Everlasting Life Christian Center in the United States with affiliate churches in Maryland, Virginia, and also in the continent of Africa in Nigeria and Ghana. Born in Lagos, Nigeria, Apostle Samuel showed exceptional skills in academics and sports which earned him a scholarship to study in the United States. He graduated from New Mexico Military Institute in Roswell, New Mexico, with an Associate of Arts degree in Business Administration. He later received a Bachelor's degree in Business Management from the University of the District of Columbia and soon furthered his education by securing both a Master's and Doctorate degrees in Theology from the Canon Bible Institute in Florida.

In 1994, together with his wife, Marcia Fatoki, they started a healthcare company. Pastor Samuel Fatoki was ordained as a minister in 1995. He founded the Everlasting Life Christian Center based in Maryland in 2002. Pastor Fatoki is known as an exceptional teacher of God's Word and carries an anointing of miracles with signs following. As a result of this divine gift, he hosted several successful miracle and healing crusades in Laurel, Maryland; Brooklyn, New York; and other cities in the United States. These crusades were also organized in national and international conferences.

At the Everlasting Life Christian Center, lives are restored, refreshed, revived, and reconnected to God. This is a place where real miracles occur on a regular basis and deliverance is common place for the spiritually oppressed and possessed. There have been testimonies of healing from cancer and other major diseases by the power of God. Senior Pastor Fatoki says, "My faith in God and the emphasis we place on prayer moves the hand of my Father God. He simply uses us as we humble ourselves to be His servants."
