All are invited to a fellowship lunch that follows the Divine Service in the Fellowship Hall located in the next building.



He was later appointed in the South Kerala Section to three departments as a Director. He came to the U.S. in 2003. He has decided to return back home to India to teach in a Theological Seminary. We are grateful for his extraordinary life of service and starting and pastoring a church group in the U.S. We wish God's blessing in all his future endeavors.
