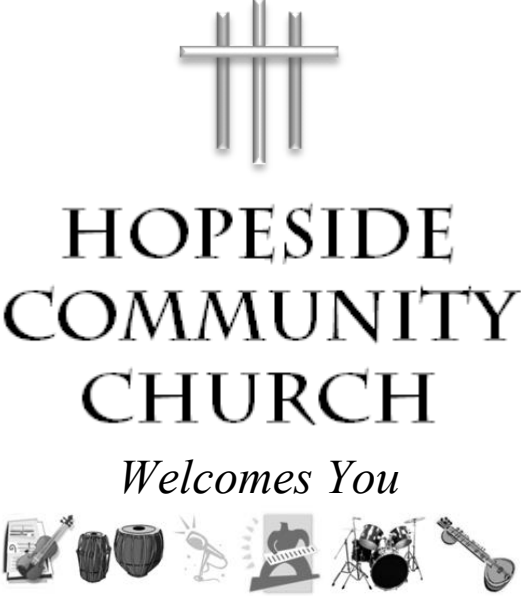
PSALMS, an interdenominational praise and worship event is every quarter on the third Saturday of the month at 6pm. This event is suspended until further notice.
